


Environmental Policy

Rappahannock Regional Solid Waste Management Board Environmental Management Policy



All of our employees are responsible for incorporating into their planning and work, the actions necessary to fulfill this commitment.

In order to meet these responsibilities, the R-Board will implement continually improving environmental practices, which endeavor to:

- To meet or exceed all applicable environmental laws, regulations and municipal standards.
- Practice the principals of the prevention of pollution in management of the facility by:
 - Reducing waste
 - Recycling
 - Monitoring hazardous waste products
 - Safe and responsible disposal of all residual waste.
- Continually improve environmental performance through self-assessment, and by responsibly correcting conditions that are potentially harmful to the environment.
- Develop and periodically review environmental objectives and targets as part of maintaining the County's environmental management system.
- Promote the education of all citizens in the awareness of environmental issues and prevention of pollution.
