  - Mr. Kelly asked are we able to look at a public private partnership for compost pickup or do something similar to what Spotsylvania County is doing
  - Mr. Pilzer will put together a list of who accepts TVs for recycling
  - Mr. Eilenfield percentage of commercial waste vs. residential?
    - Commercial% waste is around 80%
    - Residential waste is around 20%
    - Mr. Eilenfield would like a breakdown of what is going into the landfill by type
