## UNDUE ECONOMIC HARDSHIP WAIVER REQUEST FORM CITY OF FREDERICKBSURG AND STAFFORD COUNTY ONLY

Expanded Polystyrene (EPS) Foam Food Service Containers Ban

This form is to request an undue economic hardship waiver allowing your business or organization the ability to utilize single-use, EPS foam food service containers.

Prior to completing this request form, please review the law regarding requirements and eligibility. #### I. General Information

Under the Expanded polystyrene food service containers prohibited, effective July 1, 2025, no food vendor that is a restaurant or similar retail food establishment and is part of a chain with 20 or more locations offering for sale substantially the same menu items and doing business under the same name, regardless of the form of ownership of such locations, shall dispense prepared food to a customer in an expanded polystyrene food service container.

Beginning July 1, 2026, no food vendor of any type shall dispense prepared food to a customer in an expanded polystyrene food service container.

Food vendors that meet the eligibility criteria may request an undue economic hardship waiver for single-use, disposable foam food service containers through this form. Waivers granted will be valid for one year. The submission of this waiver request form does not guarantee approval of a waiver.

### II. Eligibility Criteria

A covered food vendor applies to any food vendor, which is defined as any establishment that provides prepared food for public consumption on or off its premises and includes a store, shop, sales outlet, restaurant, grocery store, supermarket, delicatessen, or catering truck or vehicle; any other person who provides prepared food; and any individual, organization, group, or state or local government entity that regularly provides food as a part of its services. To be eligible to use this form, a covered food vendor must be located in or operating in the City of Fredericksburg, Virginia, or Stafford County, Virginia.

<u>Individuals, businesses, and organizations that do not meet the criteria specified in this section are not eligible to apply for an undue economic hardship waiver</u>

2. For the purposes of this application, "undue economic hardship" means a situation in which (i) a food vendor has no reasonable alternative to the expanded polystyrene food service containers in use by that food vendor and (ii) compliance with subsection A would cause significant economic hardship to that food vendor.

Waiver renewal applications must be received by the R-Board at least 60 days prior to expiration dates listed on the previously approved waiver.
